# Learn How to Swim with our Aquatic Programs

The City of Myrtle Beach Recreation Centers offer the American Red Cross Swimming and Water Safety programs which combine swim instruction with a strong emphasis on water safety for anyone, regardless of age or skill. We offer classes for children starting at 6 months ranging all the way to senior citizens.

Our classes continue throughout the year at both our Pepper Geddings and Canal Street Recreation centers. Pepper Geddings has a 6 lane, 25 yard pool ranging from 4—12 feet, with an separate 4 foot shallow end. Canal Street has a 6 lane—25 yard shallow water pool, ranging from 3—5 feet.

## Level Classes

- 6 - 12 years old
- 45 minute classes
- Safety skills / Swimming skills
- **Level 1**—no water experience and may have a fear of water
- **Level 2**— experience in the water but no swimming skills
- **Level 3**—can swim without assistance on front and back
- **Level 4**— can swim freestyle using rotary breathing for 15 yards, and are able to swim on their back
- **Level 5**—can swim the length of the pool and want to refine swimming strokes
