

HMGP Disaster Recovery Grant Applications Myrtle Beach RFI- Public Notice for Applications

Public Notice

Myrtle Beach is submitting applications for the water rerouting and mitigation in the areas of HWY 501 at Balsam Street and Cane Patch/N Kings Hwy. Funding for this grant was made available after the 4286 Presidential declaration was made regarding the impacts of Hurricane Matthew. A public notice must be issued in accordance with 44 CFR 9.12e that states the following:

“This mitigation must occur in an area impacting a floodplain because these areas are those that the City has determined are frequently impacted by water, and there are multiple road closures and flood claims that occur to residential and business properties. There have been alternative projects considered, but it was determined that this mitigation would be the best option for mitigation in this area. Alternative and proposed projects conform to the applicable state and local flood protection standards and should positively benefit the areas located in the floodplain.”

The City of Myrtle Beach Public Works and SCDOT would be the responsible officials of this project should it be awarded, but for further information on this project, please call 407-951-0272 for additional information.
