Re: Meeting Schedule and Agendas

1. Next week's [meeting schedule](#) and agendas are attached.
2. **Expect heavy traffic this weekend between 21st and 33rd Avenues North, from Broadway at the Beach to Ocean Boulevard.** We have several events occurring between the Convention Center and Doug Shaw Memorial Stadium. The biggest is the Pee Dee Street Rodders' annual Run to the Sun car show through Saturday at the former Myrtle Square Mall site, with 3,300 classic cars. A shuttle will run between Broadway at the Beach and the car show, for easy parking, or you can park at Broadway and walk to the show along Burroughs & Chapin Boulevard. Also this weekend, the Myrtle Beach Convention Center welcomes more than 5,000 cheerleaders, while Doug Shaw Memorial Stadium is hosting the Alan Connie Shamrock Invitational Track Meet, with more than 2,000 athletes from 48 colleges and universities in 18 states. The Grand Strand Miracle League also kicks off its spring season on Saturday, March 17.
3. **Paving work will continue in coming weeks around the city.** For example, the contractor will be milling Rourk Street and Nigels Drive next Tuesday evening and then paving on Wednesday morning. Along with our regular spring paving contract, the city also will be paving additional streets with funds provided by RIDE III.
4. **Sign up now for the 2018 Military Appreciation Days Parade, to be held Saturday, May 26, on Farrow Parkway at The Market Common.** You'll find the parade registration forms, along with other information about our May activities, at the newly updated web site, www.militaryappreciationdays.com. This year's Grand Marshal is Army Reserve Captain Deshauna Barber, who also was the 2016 Miss USA.
