Motion M2020-57 authorizing the City Manager or his designee to apply for a grant of \$10,000 from the AARP Community Challenge Grant program for the purpose of creating vinyl wraps with artwork, wayfinding map and pedestrian/bicycle safety information to be installed on traffic cabinets at 10 strategic intersections, to record the appropriation of such grant funds in the amount that may be approved, and to execute and deliver the grant agreement and such related documents as may be required to put the grant into effect. No match is required.

The AARP Community Challenge Grant provides funding for projects that will help to improve transportation alternatives specifically for people over 50. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee, Transportation-Related Issues Committee, and the Beautification Committee have all participated in this effort to determine the best locations for the vinyl wrap installations. The project must be completed before December 2020. Artrwork will be created by local artists. The map and safety information will be a joint effort of the Bicycle & Pedestrian Committee and Planning and Public Works Departments.

Locations for installation: Kings Hwy & Main St, Mr Joe White Ave & Oak St, Kings Hwy & 9th Ave N, Kings Hwy & State Park entrance, Grissom Pkwy & Harrelson Blvd, Kings Hwy & Farrow Pkwy, Grissom Pkwy & 21st Ave N, Kings Hwy & 3rd Ave S, Kings Hwy & Harrelson Blvd, Kings Hwy & 13th Ave S
