- 12 • The Police Department applied for funding in the total amount of \$38,117 for the
13 purpose of Simunition conversion kits, guns, marking rounds and protective
14 equipment to facilitate live-action reality-based training for police officers.
- 15 • By Motion M2021-105, Council opened the 30-day Governing Body Review on
16 July 27, 2021 as required by the Grantor. That review period has now expired.
- 17 • City Council held a public hearing on September 14, 2021 as required by the
18 Grantor.
- 19 • This resolution confirms the completion of the Governing Body Review
20 requirement.

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program allows units of local government to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime based on their own local needs and conditions;

WHEREAS, grant funds can be used for local initiatives, technical assistance training personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, and information systems for criminal justice; including any one or more of the following program areas: 1) law enforcement programs; 2) prosecution and court programs; 3) prevention and education programs; 4) corrections and community corrections programs; 5) drug treatment and enforcement programs; 6) planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs; 7) crime victim and witness programs (other than compensation) and 8) mental health programs and related law enforcement and corrections programs;

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, City Council adopted its Motion M2021-105 authorizing the City Manager or his designee to apply to the Bureau of Justice Assistance requesting funding from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant to purchase simunition conversion kits, marking rounds and protective equipment to facilitate live-action reality-based training for police officers and to acknowledge receipt of the application for the purpose of Governing Body Review that will be filed in the Office of the City Clerk where it will be available for a 30-day period;

WHEREAS, the 30-day period established for Governing Body Review has now expired;

WHEREAS, City Council held a public hearing for the purpose of Governing Body Review on September 14, 2021, 9 a.m. in the courtroom of the Law Enforcement Center at 1101 N. Oak Street;
