- The Technology Advisory Group (TAG) will be using the building at 509/511 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue North as an Innovation Center/Co-Work Space.
- The purpose is to drive innovation to the downtown area that supports entrepreneurs while addressing barriers to accessibility, building community, resource sharing & collaboration.
- An important aspect of the project is to get the word out to potential small & microbusinesses.
- If approved, the \$25,000 MASC Hometown Economic Development Grant (and \$3,750 in local match funding will be used for marketing, branding & promoting this project & purchasing office furnishings for the co-work space..

<u>Issues</u>: In proposed resolution Council attests to the availability of 15% matching funds to be immediately available from the 2019-20 appropriation to TAG.

TO APPROVE THE ALLOCATION OF \$3,750 TO MEET THE 15% MATCHING REQUIREMENT FOR THE MUNICIPAL ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA'S HOMETOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT - \$25,000; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Association of SC is offering a Hometown Economic Development grant in the amount of \$25,000 to implement economic development projects that will make a positive impact on the quality of life in SC communities;

- WHEREAS, economic development activities eligible for funding include professional services for branding/promoting local businesses and programs developed by a city including downtown development/revitalization/ business incubators/small business assistance;
- WHEREAS, the City of Myrtle Beach and its Technology Advisory Group are developing and implementing an Innovation Center/Co-Work Space at 509 and 511 9<sup>th</sup> Ave N in the Arts and Innovation District; and
- WHEREAS, the City is applying for grant assistance for branding/marketing services and to purchase office furnishings for the Innovation Center/Co-Work Space.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Myrtle Beach, in meeting duly assembled, that
  - 1) The City hereby commits to provide a local cash match of \$3,750, which equals the minimum 15% local match required by the Municipal Association of South Carolina, to support the City of Myrtle Beach application for a \$25,000 Hometown Economic Development Grant. These grant and local matching funds will be used for branding/marketing and office furnishings for the Innovation Center/Co-Work Space.
  - 2) The source of matching funds will be from the \$40,000 set aside to assist TAG in the development of the Innovation Center.
  - 3) The City will follow its procurement policy adopted in accordance with SC Code of Laws Section 11-35-50 when securing all services and products purchased with funds awarded from a Hometown Economic Development Grant.
  - 4) This resolution is made in regard to the submission of an application for Hometown Economic Development Grants funds to the Municipal Association of South Carolina on or before September 27, 2019.
  - 5) The City Manager and his designees are hereby authorized to submit application for the grant.
  - 6) Upon approval of the subject grant, the acceptance, appropriation, and recording of the grant funds in the approved amount is hereby authorized.
  - 7) The City Manager and his designees are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the grant agreement and such related documents as may be required for this purpose.
