- 6. Engineering/design of iTAP utilities-\$63k
- 7. Seagate Village Fire hydrants (36)-\$255k
- 8. Water line to FAA tower-\$210k
- 9. Grand Park Linear Path-\$300k
- 10. Jack Walker (Eastcoast Greenway) Trailhead-\$50k
- 11. Historic signage-\$110
- 12. Wall of Service-\$112k
- 13. Painting Warbird Park airplanes-\$80k
- 14. Thunderbolt Park-\$200k
- 15. Matching funds for SC Recreation grant-\$25k
